



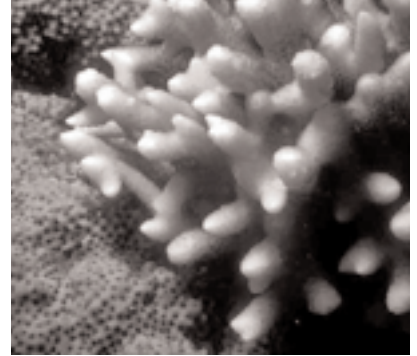
# U.S.S. ORISKANY Dive Package

## APRIL 28 - MAY 1, 2008

### Pensacola, Florida

#### The Diving

Three days of two tanks dives at the Oriskany, the largest ship ever sunk for divers and artificial reef located in the Gulf of Mexico 26 miles from Pensacola, Florida. The Oriskany was decommissioned and after years of bidding, Florida won the right to sink its first ever aircraft carrier to date making it the premier destination for wreck diving in the U.S. The Oriskany offers the recreational diver the opportunity to explore at minimum depths of 50 feet to over 220 feet for the more advanced technical diver wanting a more challenging dive. Our IVS team will not only dive recreational, but offer the ability for technical mixed gas dives for those qualified or wanting to sign up for a tech class to further their diving education. Our host will be MBT Divers with their fast 36' Newton Dive boat. Lodging will be next door at Pensacola Suburban Lodge.



#### The Package:

- 3 days 2 tank dives (5 Oriskany & 1 reef)
- 3 nights accommodation double occupancy
- Weights

#### Cost:

**\$760.00** per person double occupancy for diving package & lodging.

Trip insurance is highly recommended and not included in package pricing.

Participant is responsible for meals & transportation to/from Pensacola.

Divers must provide their own gear and tanks (rentals available on-site if needed)

Divers are responsible for air fills, nitrox and trimix fills.

#### Terms:
