

Indian Valley Scuba Summer Camp I 2020

Learn to Dive Open Water +Plus! Program

Camp Dates & Times: Mon Jul 13 – Fri Jul 17, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Cost \$500 – Registration Fee includes:

- Camp fees for five day program
- PADI Open Water Diver Manual & Recreational Dive Planner with instructions
- Super cool Indian Valley Scuba Dive Team T-shirt
- Professional dive Instructor supervision & camp leadership
- Use of all equipment for confined water sessions
- Academic sessions and preparation for Open Water Checkout Dives (dependent on successful completion of all skills and academic requirements, including final exam)
- Lunch and snacks
- Discount coupon for purchase of gear (20% off any equipment items, valid for 30 days after camp (expires Aug 15))

Overview:

Campers must register no later than Saturday, June 27, and pick up their Crew Pak and homework assignments. Homework must be completed prior to each days session (KR1 before Day One, KR2 before Day Two, etc)

Camp will meet daily at Indian Valley Scuba's dive center and will begin with academics each morning in the classroom, including watching the PADI OW DVD (one chapter each morning)

Snacks & Lunch:

Light snacks and drinks will be offered each morning and afternoon, and a lunch will be served daily. Lunch menu consists of:

- Mon – Cheese pizza
- Tues – Hamburgers
- Weds – PB&J Sandwiches
- Thur – Hot Pockets
- Fri – Hot Dogs
- Soda, juice and water will be provided daily
- No provisions for special diets are included. Parents may send lunch and/or snacks in for their children each day or on any of the days which they may not wish to enjoy the above-mentioned menu items

After lunch each day campers will complete confined water sessions in the pool. Days 1 – 3 we will use the on-site pool, and Days 4 & 5 we'll use an off-site pool (likely the IVFYMCA). Transportation will be included to and from the pool each day.

Pickup: Pickup each day will be at 4:00 at Indian Valley Scuba or the YMCA. Parents will be advised the day of drop off.

Upon successful completion of the Scuba Camp five-day program, they are qualified to participate in the Open Water Checkout Dive option.

Details:

- Cost is \$150, which represents a discounted price available only to our camp graduates
- Fee includes use of a complete set of rental gear, two tanks, IVS 3-ring logbook binder and pages, instructor supervision for six dives, certification fees, and completion of Peak Performance Buoyancy and Coral Reef Conservation Specialty Certifications (provided the necessary dives and skills are completed during checkouts)
- Additional cost not included are entrance fee to Dutch Springs (or other IVS venue they may select, such as Bonaire or the Keys), plus additional air fills

Students who for any reason are unable to successfully complete the camp program due to absence or any challenges with skills or academics, may make these sessions up in accordance with IVS's standard make-up class provisions, including a fee of \$25 per make up session. IVS will provide all gear (including personal gear) for these makeup sessions at no additional cost

Any inclement weather during the camp week may cause us to alter the schedule as needed to accomplish the goals and requirements during the week. If this requires additional days in an indoor pool IVS will provide transportation to the pool, and back, at no additional cost.

There are no refunds for any reason, once camp begins on Monday morning, July 16th. Students who are unable to complete the camp program may make arrangements as noted above to make up missed or additional sessions. Additional fees will be assessed for these sessions.
