- Use of all equipment for Confined and Open Water sessions
- Academic sessions, confined water practice, and execution of open water dives required for successful completion PADI Advanced Open Water (or Junior Advanced Open Water) certification, as well as PADI Enriched Air Nitrox Diver and DSMB Specialty Diver certifications.
- Lunch, beverages & snacks daily
- Transportation to and from Dutch Springs
- Discount packages for purchase of personal gear after camp ends

### **Overview:**

Campers must register no later than Friday, July 13, and pick up their academic materials and homework assignments. Homework assignments must be completed prior to the start of camp. Please allow time for your camper to prepare!

Camp will meet daily at Indian Valley Scuba's dive center. The program will begin with academics, and confined water session to refresh & review all necessary skills prior to the open water dives.

### **Snacks & Lunch:**

Light snacks and drinks will be offered each morning and afternoon, and a lunch will be provided daily. Lunch menu consists of:

- Mon – Cheese pizza
- Tues – Hot Pockets
- Weds & Thurs lunches will be burgers and dogs, grilled on-site at Dutch Springs
- Fri - PB & J Sandwiches
- Soda, juice and water will be provided daily
- No provisions for special diets are included. Parents may send lunch and/or snacks in for their children each day or on any of the days which they may not wish to enjoy the above-mentioned menu items

We plan to spend Monday in the classroom reviewing the academics and skills required for the upcoming dives. Tuesday we'll complete the academics for the open water dives, then head to the pool for skills practice and review. This will also serve as an in-depth refresher for all the divers. Wednesday and Thursday, we'll head up to Dutch Springs, and plan to complete three dives each day as required for the certifications. Friday will be devoted to the nitrox class, as well as equipment care and maintenance with some hands-on sessions in our service area.

Transportation will be included to and from the pool or Dutch Springs each day, but parents are welcome to drive their campers each day.

**Pickup:** Pickup each day will at 4:00 at Indian Valley Scuba or the YMCA, depending on which location we are using that day. Parents will be advised which location for the day when they drop off in the morning.

**Upon successful completion of the Advanced Scuba Camp five-day program, participants will earn their PADI Adventure Diver, Advanced Open Water Diver, DSMB Specialty Diver, and Enriched Air Nitrox Diver certification. In the event that for whatever reason they are unable to complete the required dives or skills needed, a make-up session can be arranged to complete the necessary work required to earn the certification. There will be an additional fee for make-ups.**

**Details:**

- Camp Fee includes use of a complete set of rental gear, all necessary scuba tanks and air fills, instructor supervision for all dives, PADI certification fees, and completion of the certification levels listed above.
- Additional cost not included are entrance fee to Dutch Springs (or other IVS venue they may select, such as Bonaire or the Florida Keys), plus additional air fills as required.

Students who for any reason are unable to successfully complete the camp program due to absence or any challenges with skills or academics, may make these sessions up in accordance with IVS's standard make-up class provisions, including a fee of \$25 per make up session. IVS will provide all gear (including personal gear) for these makeup sessions at no additional cost



There are no refunds for any reason, once camp begins on Monday morning. Students who are unable to complete the camp program during the scheduled sessions may make arrangements as noted above to make up missed or additional sessions. Additional fees will be assessed for these sessions.
