## THE TRIP - Deliberately Different, of course!

Our annual trek to Florida's Southeast Coast is a bit different than most of our many of our other adventures, as it's a multi-part event that combines a variety of amazing yet unique dive experiences. It includes shore diving at the world-famous Blue Heron Bridge, drift diving on the reefs off Boca Raton, hunting Spiny Lobsters offshore, and a most amazing shark feeding activity that will leave you absolutely breathless! This trip is offered as a two-part combination.

## THE LODGING


Our base of operations for this trip is a private rented villa in Boca Raton. Sporting multiple bedrooms and sleeping ten guests, it comes complete with a pool, barbecue, fire pit, pool table, futsal game, plus a fully furnished kitchen, dining room, and more. Conveniently located in the center of town, close to restaurants, eateries and attractions, the double occupancy rooms offer twin and queen bed options, multiple bathrooms, washer/dryer, and everything else one could need for a grand vacation with friends.

## THE DIVING

Another IVS-exclusive adventure, this trip brings you the best of Southeast Florida diving! We start with a full day of diving under the Blue Heron Bridge, one of the top rated dive sites (and one of the few accessible by shore) in the US. Picking the best times based on tide and water flows, we'll enter this beautiful, protected area and complete multiple dives over the course of the day. Filled with tropical life, the BHB offers great conditions, minimal stress, and tons of upside potential to divers of all levels.

On Sunday our plans include a morning 2-tank boat trip to the reefs and wrecks located just offshore. Warm waters, generally great visibility and even more sea life will fill these dives with exploration adventure. Sunday evening, conditions permitting, we plan to go back to the bridge for another dive, to see how the undersea life changes when the sun starts to go down.

Monday morning we're back on the reef, with a chance to dive BHB later, on we repeat this on Tuesday to end Part I of the trip. Wednesday begins Part II, with morning & afternoon 2-tank lobster hunting trips offshore. Thursday's the same, and assuming the positive, we'll gather for a lobster fest & BBQ later that evening. Friday's schedule includes a 3-tank shark and wreck trip out of Jupiter to end the week with a high dose of adrenalin in our systems! Finally it's time to finally rinse & dry the gear, say our goodbyes (for now) and head home Saturday.
